GENERAL INFORMATION:

Entries must be send before 7th October 2017

Send your videos for auditions on, or before 9th October 2017. In each dance category, 2 teams from one group, can come for audition. Only one team from each category will perform in finals. For rangoli and drawing, no auditions will be conducted. Society needs to share the list of participants to us.

TYPE OF ENTRIES:

Dance form can be any, props should be used atleast for 30seconds and also fusion should also be included.

TIME LIMITS:

5 minutes for solo and 6minutes for group performance, including the prop setup. Delay in performance scheduled, will result in deduction of marks or disqualification. In case the competition is running early then the schedule, all the dancers should be ready to perform, one hour prior to their scheduled time and are expected to be in stage when called.

Props once allotted or selected would not be changed. Also, props including fire, color, water or nay flammable substance, will not be allowed on the stage.

MUSIC:

Each entry must furnish their music on high quality, individual CD during performance. Music submitted on iPods will not be accepted. All CD's must contain only one song, recorded in the cue with the proper speed. Song title, name of the dance group along with society name, should be mentioned on the CD. It is highly recommended that, contestants bring back up music in case of emergency or malfunctioning.

JUDGING:

Contestants will be judged by Pre-decided panel of judges and all the entrants will agree to the final decision taken by the judges. Each performance will be evaluated on the following five factors:

- 1. Technique- 30
- Stage Presence- 15
- 3. Fusion- 10
- 4. Costume-20
- Timing and Music- 5
- 6. Choreography- 20

RANGOLI AND DRAWING:

Minimum size of rangoli should be 2x2sq ft. For drawing A3 sheets should be used. Participants need to carry colors and other materials they require. Nothing will be provided by the organizing committee. 2 people would be allowed for rangoli in each team whereas drawing is an individual activity.

NOTE:

Only single entry for each competition per society in final event. Participants from every society should be a resident of the same. Outsiders are not allowed. Judges decision will be final. Pride Purple Properties has all the rights to cancel the event without any prior notice.
